DRAFT RESOLUTION SUBMITTED BY THE DELEGATION OF  
ECUADOR (Conference Room Paper No. 34) (continued)

The CHAIRMAN put to the vote the draft resolution submitted by the delegation of Ecuador, as redrafted by the Working Group consisting of Argentina, Bolivia, Brazil, Ecuador, Mexico, the United States of America and Venezuela (Conference Room Paper No. 34).

The draft resolution was approved unanimously.

PRODUCTIVITY OF THE COFFEE INDUSTRY (E/CN.12/435) (continued)

Mr. DUARTE (El Salvador) submitted a draft resolution regarding the desirability of continuing the studies on coffee and the possibility of setting up a training centre on the subject.

After a general discussion of the draft resolution, the CHAIRMAN said that, in view of the difficulty of reaching agreement on the wording of the resolution, the Committee would recess for ten minutes, in order to give the members an opportunity to agree upon an acceptable text.

The meeting was suspended at 4.10 p.m. and resumed at 4.20 p.m.

The CHAIRMAN put to the vote the draft resolution submitted by the delegation of El Salvador, as amended.

The draft resolution was approved.
