COMMUNICATION OF THE INTER-AMERICAN ECONOMIC AND
SOCIAL COUNCIL

The Resolution No. 10 referred to above is as follows:

DIVISION OF FUNCTIONS BETWEEN THE ECONOMIC COMMISSION
FOR LATIN AMERICA AND THE INTER-AMERICAN ECONOMIC AND
SOCIAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS:

The functions assigned to the Economic Commission for Latin America established by the Economic and Social Council of the United Nations in its meeting of 25 February 1948, are essentially similar to those of the Inter-American Economic and Social Council, approved by this Conference;

In order to prevent duplication in the organization and work of the two organizations,

THE NINTH INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE OF AMERICAN STATES

RESOLVES:

1. That the Inter-American Economic and Social Council shall appoint a committee of not more than three members, to meet with the Economic Commission for Latin America at Santiago, Chile, next June, to draft an appropriate formula for the functioning of the two organizations, and to outline their respective fields of activity and their general programmes including liaison between the two organizations so as to avoid the aforesaid duplication in organization, personnel and functions.
2. That the results of this joint meeting shall be submitted for approval to the Economic and Social Council of the United Nations and the Inter-American Economic and Social Council. Pending their approval, any concrete study planned by the Economic Commission for Latin America or the Inter-American Economic and Social Council relating to organization, personnel, or substantive work, should be carried out only after detailed consideration by the joint meeting for the purposes of consultation mentioned above.
