THE ECONOMIC COMMISSION FOR LATIN AMERICA:

TAKES NOTE of the "Economic Survey of Latin America"
(E/CN.12/82) presented by the Executive Secretary in compliance
with the Resolution of 23 June 1948 (E/CN.12/79);

REQUESTS: That the Executive Secretary prepare
basic surveys of Latin American economic conditions along
the lines of the above Resolution, with particular emphasis
on the analysis of economic conditions and their causes;
that in future reports due consideration be given to the
views expressed by the members of the Commission during the
discussion of previous surveys; and that special attention
be paid to the analysis of the labour factor in its various
aspects;

RECOMMENDS that at the earliest opportunity and, if
possible, before August 15, 1949, Member Governments transmit
to the Executive Secretary any suggestions which they deem
necessary for the preparation of the next report;

DRAWS THE ATTENTION of Member Governments to paragraph
2 of the Resolution adopted by the Commission on 23 June 1948;

REQUESTS FURTHER that the Executive Secretary summarize
the findings of each annual Economic Survey and, as far as
possible, present any recommendations he may consider advisable.
