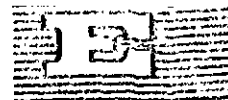

Corrigendum

Page 1, lines 21 to 28

Amend to read as follows:

"essential services. If it is assumed that the standard of living (as measured by per capita income) is to rise at the rate of 2 per cent per year which can hardly be considered an accelerated rate, then the gross product will have to expand by about 150 per cent by 1975, with agricultural production increasing by 90 per cent and industrial production almost three times. In order to achieve a national income growth of 2.7 per cent per capita, industrial production would have to rise by about four times over the present volume. These preliminary..."
