ANNUAL REPORT OF THE ECONOMIC COMMISSION FOR
LATIN AMERICA

Resolution approved 16 June 1951

The Commission decided to submit the following resolution
for action by the Economic and Social Council:

A

THE ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL COUNCIL

TAKES NOTE of the Annual Report of the Economic Commission
for Latin America, (Document E/2021);

DECIDES that the Commission should be continued indefinitely
as it has proved its usefulness and effectiveness in dealing with
regional economic problems within the policies established by the
United Nations;

DECIDES to amend the terms of reference as follows:

(1) to add the end of paragraph one, two sub-paragraphs
to read:

(d) Pay special attention in its activities to the
problems of economic development and assist in the
formulation and implementation of integrated
measures which would direct practical action
towards furthering the economic development of the
region.

(a) Assist the Economic and Social Council and its Technical Assistance Committee in the discharge of their functions under the United Nations Technical Assistance Programme and, in particular, in the evaluation of these activities in Latin America.

(2) to delete the paragraph sixteen

B

THE ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL COUNCIL,

CONSIDERING that the work programme of the Commission as established at its fourth session is of primary importance for the economic development of Latin America.

TAKING INTO ACCOUNT that ECLA is the most recent regional economic commission and should have given the same opportunities for development of its work as other regional commissions;

RECOMMENDS that the necessary funds should be made available to implement fully the 1951-1952 Work Programme of the Commission, included in its Annual Report (Document E/2021);

THE ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL COUNCIL,

TAKES NOTE of the Commission decision to hold its fifth session in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil, at such a date as the Executive Secretary, after consultation with the Chairman, shall determine, in the light of decisions by the Council regarding its 1952 Calendar of Meetings.
