Resolution on the Basic Reports of the Secretariat

Adopted by the Committee

THE ECONOMIC COMMISSION FOR LATIN AMERICA:

TAKES NOTE of the "Economic Survey of Latin America" (E/CN.12/82) presented by the Executive Secretary in response to the request of the Resolution of ECLA of 23 June 1948 (E/CN.12/79);

REQUESTS that the Executive Secretary prepare yearly a basic report on the Latin American economic conditions, on the pattern determined by the Santiago Resolution, with the particular emphasis on the analysis of economic conditions and their causes; and that in these future reports due consideration be given to the views expressed by the members of the Commission during the discussion of the previous surveys;

RECOMMENDS that at the earliest opportunity and, if possible, before August 15, 1949, Member Governments offer the Executive Secretary the suggestions that they deem necessary for the preparation of the next report;

DRAWS THE ATTENTION of Member Governments of ECLA to item 2 of the Resolution of 23 June 1948;

REQUESTS FURTHER that the Executive Secretary summarize the findings of the Survey and, as far as possible, present any recommendations he may consider advisable.
