Brasil: Draft Resolution

THE ECONOMIC COMMISSION FOR LATIN AMERICA

TAKES NOTE ~~of the~~ statement of Executive Secretary on
"measures relating to international action for conservation and
utilization of non-agricultural resources" (Document E/CN.12/231).

CONSIDERING the resolution adopted by the United Nations
Economic and Social Council (Document E/1946) providing (A) for
the promotion of systematic survey and inventory of non-
agricultural resources; and (B) for the holding of international
conferences to deal with particular problems of non-agricultural
resources.

CONSIDERING that the resolution in question requests the
regional economic commissions "to consider the present resolution
and to make such recommendations" as they would consider useful.

CONSIDERING that the resolution calls for consultation,
when appropriate, with the regional economic commissions to
explore the scope and subject matter of any particular conferences

which may be desirable.

TAKES NOTE that surveys and inventories of non-agricultural resources in Latin America and the systematic compilation of such information would constitute an important means of furthering the economic development of the region.

RECOMMENDS that in planning Conferences of this nature, the Secretary General take into consideration points one through ten suggested by the Executive Secretary in his note on measures relating to International Action for Conservation and Utilization of Non-Agricultural Resources.
