Continuation of the Economic Survey of Latin America and
Studies in the Field of Economic Development on a Permanent Basis

Cuba: Draft Resolution

THE ECONOMIC COMMISSION FOR LATIN AMERICA,

CONSIDERING that it is desirable to continue on a permanent basis the analysis of the economic phenomena of Latin America begun by the Secretariat; and

TAKING INTO ACCOUNT that in the light of experience, a distinction should be made between the examination of recent developments and trends in the various economies on the one hand, and the studies of economic development on the other:

RECOMMENDS to the Secretariat that it should:

1. CONTINUE on a permanent basis the preparation of an annual economic survey including a systematic examination and interpretation of recent developments and trends in the economy of Latin American countries;

2. CONTINUE, in the same manner as in the past, the studies of economic development, covering the following subjects:

(a) the economic development of each one of the Latin American countries;

(b) interpretation of the different aspects of the process of economic development;

(c) comparative analysis of the problems of development in the different Latin American countries and of the measures being taken to solve them; and

(d) examination of development plans and programmes and of their results.
