Colonization of mountainous areas

Peru: Draft resolution

THE ECONOMIC COMMISSION FOR LATIN AMERICA,

CONSIDERING that immigration into certain Latin American countries is in fact a process of developing lands without people which are awaiting people without land;

CONSIDERING that this process, which is tantamount to colonization by means of immigration, requires special scientific study such as that made last year in the Huallaga River area;

CONSIDERING that studies of this type should be supplemented by others suggesting the best methods of carrying out such colonization;

RECOMMENDS that studies should be made with a view to the framing of detailed colonization plans for those areas which scientific study shows to be suited for that purpose.
