## II. ANNOTATIONS ON THE PROVISIONAL AGENDA

### 1. Election of Officers

In accordance with the ECLAC Rules of Procedure and established practice, it is necessary to elect a group of Officers consisting of a Chairman, two Vice-Chairmen and a Rapporteur.

### 2. Adoption of the agenda

Delegates may wish to consider and adopt the agenda prepared by the Secretariat and contained in this document. In this connection, delegations may, of course, make such observations and suggest such amendments as they consider appropriate, bearing in mind the time limitations imposed by the present budgetary restrictions.

### 3. Handling of the economic crisis

In this agenda item, for which the Secretariat prepared document LC/L.422, an analysis will be made of the main events which have influenced the evolution of the Latin American and Caribbean economies in 1986 and the first half of 1987 and the way in which such events could affect the future economic development of those countries. In particular, as decided by the Commission in ECLAC resolution 478(XXI), an analysis will be made of recent events, in both debtor and creditor countries, connected with the external indebtedness of the region.

### 4. Adoption of the report

The final report of the meeting will be submitted by the Rapporteur for the approval of the representatives of member governments present.
