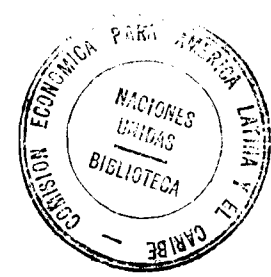


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## PREFACE



Intercensal estimates are essential for the analysis of demographic movements between two censuses. They are also invaluable in the preparation of economic series, the derivation of demographic information, and for the refinement of social indicators required by planners and policy makers.

Within its sub-programme of data generation and evaluation activities for improved population-development planning, the ECLAC/CELADE Unit, Port-of-Spain, has conducted a study on the preparation of intercensal estimates in collaboration with the University of the West Indies, Jamaica, and the national statistical offices. An offshoot of this study has been the conduct of a three-day regional training workshop under the direction of Professor George Roberts, University of the West Indies (U.W.I.), to strengthen capabilities of governments for preparing their own intercensal estimates. In addition a microcomputer program and a user's manual were developed.

The assistance of the United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA) in providing funding for the study and this publication through the UNFPA/ECLAC regional project "Integration of Population in Development Planning" is gratefully acknowledged.

It is hoped that the information contained in this study will contribute to improved population-development planning in the Caribbean.

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## INTRODUCTION

National Statistical Offices have been publishing annual post-censal estimates of population by age and sex, based on recorded vital statistics and migration data. With few exceptions, however, these have often proved inaccurate when compared with the later census count. These errors of closure are assumed to be due either to inadequacies in the migration data or incompleteness of the vital registration data. Consequently, there is need for a well co-ordinated programme to prepare a series of intercensal estimates of population by age and sex.

Estimates of intercensal population for Caribbean countries were first prepared as part of the 1946 Census of the West Indies. These were designed to trace movements in the populations and vital rates between 1921 and 1943-46 and were, therefore, not in terms of age and sex (Hopkins, 1950). As part of the 1960 Census Research Programme, a project was organized for preparing intercensal populations by age and sex for all countries included in that census. These estimates formed the subject of Bulletin 8 of the Census Research Programme (Roberts and Harewood, 1964). No similar project was set up in connection with the 1970 census.

In view of the value of estimates of intercensal populations by age and sex for many types of analysis, a project has been organized by the ECLAC/CELADE Demography Unit and the University of the West Indies (UWI) to prepare estimates of this nature for the period 1970-1980. Unfortunately, because of the poor state of vital statistics in several Caribbean countries, tabulations of deaths by age and sex, which are necessary for the calculation of such estimates, were not available. This meant that estimates of this form could not be derived for many countries of the region. In fact, the only countries for which such calculations could be carried out are: Trinidad and Tobago, Barbados, Belize, Saint Lucia, St. Kitts and Nevis, and Grenada. It is unfortunate that two of the larger countries of the region - Jamaica and Guyana - have had to be excluded from this publication because of the unavailability of the requisite data.

Section A describes the data to be used and outlines the methodology of preparing the intercensal estimates. The method used in this publication lends itself to a computer application and an outline of the program written for this purpose is set out. As an illustration of its use, the calculation of estimates for females of Trinidad and Tobago by means of the program is shown in detail.

The actual estimates for the six countries are presented in Section B under Tables B.1 to B.6. The components of growth used to compute the population estimates are summarised in Tables C.1 to C.6. Tables on births, deaths, natural increase and infant mortality rates are illustrated in Section D.





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**SECTION A**

# Preparation of Revised Intercensal Population Estimates for Caribbean Populations, 1970 to 1980, with a Computer Application

## Data used

Two sets of population data are required: the age distributions of the censuses of 1970 and 1980. These constitute the initial and terminal points for the intercensal estimates. In terms of vital statistics, data on mortality and fertility for intervening years are required. In addition, net migration balances for each year, by sex, have to be used. Deaths are required by single years of age for the construction of the lower segment estimates, which are in terms of single years of age. For the upper segment, deaths and migration balances have to be available in terms of 5-year age groups. Births for the years 1964 to 1980 are required in terms of male and female, while sex breakdowns are needed for net external migration data also.

## Methodology

The present method follows broadly that of Bulletin 8, but there is one major difference between the two: this relates to the treatment of external migration. The method used in Bulletin 8 dealt with each country's population in terms of two age segments. For the first and smaller segment, covering the population under 5 in 1946 up to those under age 15 in 1960, one set of estimates - forward estimates - was prepared on the basis of births, deaths and net external migration.

For the second and larger segment, commencing with the population aged 5 and over in 1946 and extending to the population over 15 in 1960, weighted means of the forward and backward estimates are used. Forward estimates for 1947, 1948,.... 1959, were obtained by aging the 8-year age cohorts of the 1946 census one year at a time. Backward estimates were secured by starting with 8-year age cohorts of 1960 and adding appropriate numbers of deaths and net emigration for the years 1959, 1958,....,1947. Combinations of the forward and backward counts by means of appropriate weights yielded required 8-year groups of intercensal estimates.

Details of ways in which the present method departs from that followed in Bulletin 8 have now to be outlined. The major departure concerns the treatment of external migration. In Bulletin 8 age distributions of external migration were combined with age distributions of deaths to form an overall source of decrement; these served to decrease successive 8-year age cohorts in preparing forward estimates. It is here assumed that the error of closure for

the specific age group represents an estimate of net migration experienced over the intercensal period. In the process of calculating backward estimates, the net migration is assumed to be incorporated into estimates obtained for each calendar year.

As in the case of Bulletin 8, it is taken that external migration does not affect populations aged 0-4 in 1970 to 0-19 in 1980.

Let us consider first estimates for the lower segment. These cover age 0 in 1964, ages 0 and 1 in 1965, ages 0, 1, and 2 in 1966, and so on. For these ages, estimates are calculated from births and deaths. For the latter, suitable separation factors are used to separate deaths for each single year of age into two components - those occurring before a birthday and those occurring after a birthday. Or, in terms of C. Chiang's approach, the fraction of the last year of life lived by those dying in a given age group has to be taken into account (C. Chiang, 1968 and 1984).

Starting points in preparing estimates for the younger segment are birth cohorts of 1964, 1965, ..., 1979. Single-year age estimates are derived by reducing these birth cohorts by appropriate numbers of deaths by single year of age. Thus the younger segment is determined on the basis of forward estimates only and it is assumed further, that it is not affected by external migration. These estimates serve another function in the present approach: they provide adjustments to the total census counts of 1970 and 1980. As is shown in Appendix II, these adjustments involve substitution of forward estimates of population aged 0 to 4 for corresponding enumerated populations of the 1970 and 1980 censuses.

For the second segment, which starts with the age cohort 5-9 in 1970, a different method is employed. First, series of forward estimates are produced by applying decrements (deaths) to each age cohort. In this way, end of year estimates for each year from 1970 to 1980 are built up. These forward estimates, commencing with the age group 5-9, yield at 1979 estimates for age groups 15-19 and higher. Estimates of external migration balances in the preparation of age distributions of decrements are omitted in the present method. This is mainly because there is no age and sex distribution data on migration for the countries under consideration. Therefore, all age cohorts of 1970 are aged on the basis of mortality decrements only.

A second series of population estimates have to be derived; these are in fact backward estimates, which commence with the 1980 census counts and increase as we move backward towards 1970, by additions of deaths occurring during each intercensal year. When the forward and backward estimates are obtained weighted means of the two are calculated; these constitute the preliminary values of population estimates required. Actually it is not necessary to

calculate backward estimates; weighted means of the two can be derived by applying suitable weights to the error of closure for an age group. These have then to be combined with the actual forward estimates to yield the weighted mean.

After estimates for the second segment have been produced, they have to be combined with those from the lower segment in order to secure estimates of each year's population by age groups. Special adjustments have to be made in respect of the age group 5-9 for the years 1970 to 1974 and in respect of the age group 10-14 for the years 1975 to 1979.

The final step involves the use of correction factors to the estimated populations over age 5 in order to ensure that the totals of these conform to the totals established for each intercensal year.

### **An illustration of the use of the computer programme, as applied to the female population of Trinidad and Tobago**

This programme, written for Lotus 123, requires, in the first place, the execution of four sets of calculations in order to secure information essential for its operation. These involve the preparation of: adjustments to the 1970 and 1980 censuses by substituting for census counts under age 5 estimates derived from births and deaths; the preparation of revised totals of intercensal populations; and the derivation of weights needed to obtain weighted means of the forward and backward estimates calculated in respect of each 5-year age cohort. The calculation of the required data is shown in Appendices I to IV, for the female population of Trinidad and Tobago.

Census data and vital statistics needed are straightforward. For the former, the age distribution of the two censuses in terms of single years of age under age 5 and in terms of 5-year groups at higher ages is required. From the vital statistics, births required are for the years 1964 to 1980. In terms of deaths, single year of age values are needed in order to prepare population estimates from each birth cohort from 1964 to 1980. Estimates for ages 5, 6, 7,..... have to be obtained by interpolation from groups of 5-year age values.

For the execution of the programme certain other input data have to be used. These form the subject of Tables 1, 2 and 3. (See Appendix V). All of these refer to estimates prepared for the second segment, that is, in respect of 5-year age cohorts. Entered in Table 1 are multipliers to be applied to three successive 5-year groups of deaths in order to ensure that the decrements have the same age designation as the populations from which they are to be subtracted. Multipliers in the three initial columns are applied

to the three groups 5-9, 10-14 and 15-19 for the first four years, that is 1971, 1972, 1973 and 1974, while the remaining sets of multipliers are applicable to all other sets of 5-year age groups.

Weights given in Table 2 are used to produce weighted means of forward and backward estimates. They are functions of the dates of the initial and terminal censuses. Their derivation in accordance with censuses of 1970 and 1980 are shown in Appendix IV. For convenience, another set of input data is placed in this table. These population estimates are calculated in accordance with the method set out in Appendix III.

Forward estimates produced from 5-year age cohorts of the 1970 census do not conform to the usual age group: 5-9, 10-14,.....; thus estimates for 1971 are in the grouping 6-10, 11-15,....., and estimates for 1972 are in the form 7-11, 12-16,..... This also holds for backward estimates and weighted means of the two series. These groupings have to be converted to the usual 5-year intervals for each of the intercensal years. Interpolation multipliers for effecting this are presented in Table 3.

### **The higher segment**

Table 4 (See Appendix V) shows the basic data for producing estimates for this segment. The census population of 1970 constitutes the initial age cohorts which have to be aged by successive subtractions of appropriate numbers of deaths, derived by applying the multipliers taken from Table 1. These processes yield forward estimates, which form the subject of Table 5 (See Appendix V). The terminal values of these estimates have to be compared with the 1980 census counts in order to obtain the errors of closure for each 5-year age group.

Weights given in Table 2 are applied to the appropriate error of closure to produce adjustments to the forward estimates; these adjustments, when combined with the forward estimates convert the latter into weighted means, which form the subject of Table 6. (See Appendix V).

Further corrections to the weighted means have to be applied, but these are best left for consideration after an outline of the method of treating estimates at younger ages.

### **The lower segment**

Estimates prepared for this segment are derived from births and deaths and yield values for single years of age. Table 7 (See Appendix V) sets out the basic data from which these estimates are prepared. Deaths by single years of age are available for ages



under 5, while single year of age estimates for 6 to 14 are obtained by interpolation from quinquennial groups. Table 8 (See Appendix V) shows estimates by single years of age for successive birth cohorts from 1964 to 1980.

### Combination of the Two Segments

Here populations under age 5 from 1970 to 1974 are derived from single year of age estimates from births and deaths, while those under age 10 for 1975 to 1979 are similarly obtained. For higher ages, interpolation formulae are used to convert the weighted means from cohort form into the usual quinquennial age grouping. This is done by applying the interpolation formulae given in Table 3.

Provisional results of the combination appear in Table 9 (See Appendix V). There are two components for the age group 5-9 in respect of the years 1970 to 1974. The first component represents fractions of single-year values and completed single year populations, both derived from the lower segment. Thus in respect of 1970, the figure of 11,269 is calculated as follows :

$$.75 * 15,026 = 11,269$$

Again the first component for 1971 is calculated as follows :

$$14,412 + (.75 * 15,016) = 25,674$$

First components for 1972, 1973 and 1974 are similarly calculated from single year estimates given in Table 8.

The second components for the age interval 5-9 are obtained from initial interpolation formulae of Table 3 applied to weighted means of Table 6. Similarly in respect of estimates for the age group 10-14, there are two components, the first derived from single year estimates from the lower segment and from values of the higher segment which are obtained by application of interpolation multipliers of Table 3.

The final steps involve corrections of the estimates in Table 9 in order to ensure that they agree with those established for the intercensal years in Appendix III. It is here assumed that the differences between the two sets of totals may largely be ascribed to deficiencies in data on external migration and that the latter source of decrement affects only populations over age 5. The derivation of appropriate correction factors for these ages is shown in Table 10 (See Appendix V) and the corrected estimates of the population appear in Table 11 (See Appendix V).

## Computer programme for calculating intercensal estimates of population by age

This programme is to be used with the Lotus 1-2-3 spreadsheet package. It runs on Lotus 1-2-3 Release 2.\*. The personal computer to be used must be an IBM compatible with a RAM of 640K. The printer used should be able to compress print. The name of the file to be retrieved by Lotus 123 is INTERCENSAL.WK1., which is stored on the diskette.

### Data entry

For calculating intercensal population estimates by age and sex, the following information is necessary:

1. Interpolation coefficients to be applied to deaths during the period 1970-1980 (Table 1).
2. Weights applicable to forward and backward estimates in order to obtain weighted means (Table 2).
3. Interpolation coefficients for breaking down weighted means of forward and backward estimates into age groups 5-9, 10-14, ...80+ (Table 3).
4. Census populations for 1970 and 1980, as well as deaths by 5-year age groups, for 1970 to 1980 (Table 4).
5. Deaths for ages 0, 1, 2, ....14, occurring in the years 1964 to 1980 (Table 7).
6. Name of country and sex of population (Table 12)

## **APPENDICES**

## Appendices

The following appendices present four basic steps needed to construct the estimates. Appendices I and II show how the adjustments to the totals of the 1970 and 1980 censuses are calculated from estimates of single year of age populations shown in Table 8. Appendix III shows how the revised total populations given in Appendices I and II are used, in conjunction with recorded natural increase and net external migration, to produce revised intercensal population totals. Appendix IV shows how the weight applicable to the populations of 1970 and 1980 is derived, when the date of the initial census is 7 April 1970 and the date of the terminal census is 12 May 1980.

### Appendix I

#### CALCULATION OF ADJUSTMENT TO THE 1970 CENSUS POPULATION

This adjustment is based on the population aged 0-4. On the assumption that the census population within this age range is subject to errors of under enumeration, estimates based on births and deaths are calculated and these are taken as the basis for deriving adjusted populations at the census date. Thus for the 1970 census the estimated populations at 7 April 1970 are taken as interpolated values between the end of the year populations under age 5 at 1969 and 1970. The census population under age 5, according to the census, is rejected and estimates based on the births and deaths are substituted.

The difference between the population aged 0-4 based on births and deaths and the census count is 67,347 - 60,326 = 7,021. The adjusted census population is, therefore, 471,559 + 7,021 = 478,580.

## Appendix II

### CALCULATION OF ADJUSTMENT TO THE 1980 CENSUS POPULATION

The calculation follows closely the approach adopted in respect of the 1970 census population. But because the date of enumeration in the 1980 differs from that of 1970, different interpolation multipliers have to be used.

The calculation of the adjustment to the 1980 census population is as follows:

Difference between population aged 0-4 based on births and deaths and census count is 67,302 - 63,120 = 4,182. The adjusted 1980 census population is, therefore, 540,151 + 4,182 = 544,333.

## Appendix III

### REVISED TOTAL POPULATIONS, 1970 TO 1980

These estimates are derived from the revised census totals for 1970 and 1980, the natural increase and net external migration for each calendar year, except for the initial and terminal periods. Initial values for natural increase and net external migration refer to the period from the date of the census to the end of 1970. Terminal values refer to the period from the end of 1979 to the date of the 1980 census.

Revised annual net migration estimates are derived by applying to the recorded values a correction factor obtained from the revised censuses of 1970 and 1980, as well as the recorded natural increase, recorded net migration and resulting error of closure.

## Appendix IV

### DERIVATION OF WEIGHTS APPLICABLE TO FORWARD AND BACKWARD ESTIMATES

These are derived from the accumulated distribution of number of days between the census dates of 7 April, 1970 and 12 May, 1980. It is taken that the revised census population totals for 1970 and 1980, with adjustments for ages under 5 are correct and that estimates for each intervening year can be obtained by applying appropriate weights to end of year forward and backward estimates. On the assumption that the forward estimates based on the 1970 census counts carry an initial weight of unity, weights for intervening years can be built up. These are calculated from the accumulated frequency distribution of number of days between the two census dates (3,687). For instance the end of year population for 1974 is .531 times the forward estimates plus .469 times the backward estimates.
