ANNOTATED PROVISIONAL AGENDA

A. BACKGROUND

The Regional Conference on Women in Latin America and the Caribbean is a subsidiary body of the Economic Commission for Latin America and the Caribbean (ECLAC) that brings together government representatives to monitor fulfilment of international and regional agreements on gender equality.

In consultation with the Government of the Dominican Republic, in its capacity as Chair of the Presiding Officers elected at the twelfth session of the Regional Conference on Women in Latin America and the Caribbean, held in Santo Domingo in October 2013, the Presiding Officers agreed to hold their fifty-fourth meeting immediately before the opening of the thirteenth session of the Regional Conference, which will be held in Montevideo from 25 to 28 October 2016.

At their fifty-fourth meeting, the Presiding Officers will consider the report of the Chair on the activities undertaken since their election in Santo Domingo, and will examine the organization of work during the thirteenth session of the Regional Conference.

The secretariat will then examine the programme of work of the Conference as well as the composition of the panels of experts invited by ECLAC to speak on the topics selected for in-depth analysis during the session, in discussions scheduled for 26, 27 and 28 October.

The secretariat will report on the expressions of interest that ECLAC has received from member countries of the Regional Conference regarding participation in the next bureau of Presiding Officers.
