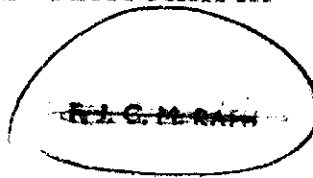

The part "Censos de 1952" consists of "Antecedentes del XII Censo de Población y I de Vivienda" as well as "national tables", all of the latter ones are with brief comments. A model of the questionnaire is included in the back, as well as a control sheet for enumeration and the "Tarjeta Infantil" used for checking on the registration of births. The second volume and the following contain each a description of the administrative regions included in the volume and a number of tables.
