Nota de la Secretaría

En el apartado 5o de la Resolución 24 (SC.2) aprobada por el Subcomité de Coordinación Estadística en su Segunda Reunión, se solicitó de los organismos internacionales pertinentes un informe acerca del programa relacionado con el Censo Agrícola Mundial de 1960 en el que participan la Organización de las Naciones Unidas para la Agricultura y la Alimentación y la Subcomisión de COINS del Instituto Interamericano de Estadística.

La Secretaría tiene el honor de presentar a la consideración del Subcomité el informe sobre el particular elaborado por la Secretaría de COINS.
