THE PULP AND PAPER INDUSTRY

Draft resolution adopted by Committee V on

12 September 1955

THE ECONOMIC COMMISSION FOR LATIN AMERICA:

TAKING INTO CONSIDERATION:

a) that the secretariat, in compliance with resolution 58 (V), organized, in co-operation with the Food Agriculture Organization of the United Nations, with the Technical Assistance Administration of the United Nations and with the Government of the Republic of Argentina, a Meeting of Experts on the Pulp and Paper Industries in Latin America, which met in Buenos Aires from 19 October to 2 November 1954 and submitted a report on this subject (document E/CN.12/370),

b) that the importance of the pulp and paper industry for economic development and the need for additional research were demonstrated both by the Meeting of Experts and in their report, and

c) that the secretariat has set up a Joint Group of Experts on the economics, construction and administration of pulp and paper mills - working on the basis of wood fibres, bagasse and other materials - and on forestry, to advise on the solution of such problems to Latin American governments requesting it, the group in question having been formed on

the initiative of the Meeting mentioned above and in collaboration with the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations and the Technical Assistance Administration of the United Nations,
