#### CONSIDERATION OF DRAFT RESOLUTIONS

Mr. DEL CAMPO (Uruguay), noting that the delegations had not had sufficient time for a careful study of the draft resolutions before them, suggested that the discussion of the draft resolutions and voting should be postponed until a later meeting.

Mr. PEÑA (El Salvador) and Mr. PALACIOS (Guatemala) supported the suggestion.

Mr. MENDEZ (Secretary of the Committee) apologized for the delay in the distribution of the draft resolutions and agreed that it would be useful to defer the discussion on them. He noted that the delegations of Chile and Peru had expressed the wish to co-sponsor the revised text submitted by Guatemala and Mexico. He further announced receipt of an Argentine amendment to that text and of a new Chilean draft resolution.

The CHAIRMAN suggested that the Committee should reconvene at 9.30 a.m. on Monday, 13 May, to resume its consideration of draft resolutions.

It was so agreed.

Mr. SOLA (Latin American Free-Trade Association) suggested, in order to gain time, that the Committee should continue to sit as an informal working group in order to give the sponsors of the various texts an opportunity to explain their intended purposes.

It was so agreed.

The meeting rose at 4.50 p.m.
