## **COMMITTEE ON SOUTH-SOUTH COOPERATION**

### **Annotated provisional agenda**

**1. Election of officers**

Under the rules of procedure of the Economic Commission for Latin America and the Caribbean and in accordance with established practice, the first order of business is for delegations to elect a chairperson, two or more vice-chairpersons and a rapporteur to direct the work of the Committee.

**2. Adoption of the agenda**

The delegations will have before them for consideration and adoption the provisional agenda (LC/G.2437(SES.33/8)). Representatives of member States may make such observations or suggest such modifications as they deem appropriate under the aforementioned rules of procedure.

**3. Report on activities carried out within the ECLAC system to promote and support South-South cooperation since the previous meeting of the Committee, held during the thirty-second session of the Commission**
