COFFEE STUDIES

Draft resolution approved by Committee III on 24 May 1957

The Economic Commission for Latin America,

Considering that the study on the efficiency and prospects of coffee growing and processing in El Salvador and the similar study in course of preparation in Colombia, under the joint ECLA/FAO programme, are of great importance for the other coffee-growing countries,

Recommends:

1. To the Governments of member countries that, if they desire guidance in the undertaking of such coffee studies or in bringing their own up to date, they so inform the ECLA secretariat, or indicate their willingness to send one or more officials of their country to receive instruction and acquire experience in the carrying-out of such studies, including the collection and analysis of data, the preparation of the findings and the establishment of bases for crop forecasts;

/2. To the ECLA

2. To the ECLA secretariat that, if a sufficient number of countries express such interest, it explore, in conjunction with FAO, the possibility of creating an appropriate training centre in one of the countries requesting the study.
