"1. The Economic Commission for Latin America ... shall ...

(a) initiate and participate in measures for  
facilitating concerted action for dealing with  
urgent economic problems arising out of the war  
and for raising the level of economic activity  
in Latin America and for maintaining and  
strengthening the economic relations of the  
Latin American countries both among themselves  
and with other countries of the world;

(b) make or sponsor such investigations and studies  
of economic and technological problems and  
developments within territories of Latin  
America as the Commission deems appropriate;

/ (c) undertake

(c) undertake or sponsor the collection, evaluation and dissemination of such economic, technological and statistical information as the Commission deems appropriate.

2. The Commission shall direct its activities especially toward the study and seeking of solutions of problems arising in Latin America from world economic maladjustment and towards other problems connected with the world economy, with a view to the co-operation of the Latin American countries in the common effort to achieve world-wide recovery and economic stability."
