ECONOMIC COMMISSION FOR LATIN AMERICA

JOINT PROPOSAL BY DELEGATIONS OF FRANCE, NETHERLANDS, UNITED
KINGDOM AND UNITED STATES CONCERNING ITEM 9 OF AGENDA:
RELATIONS WITH THE CARIBBEAN COMMISSION

The economic functions of the Caribbean Commission, as set forth in the Agreement by which it was created, are broadly similar to those of the Economic Commission for Latin America. It would, accordingly, appear desirable that appropriate steps be taken to prevent possible duplication and overlapping between the activities of the two Commissions.

With this end in view, the Delegations of France, the Netherlands, the United Kingdom and the United States, whose Governments are the four members of the Caribbean Commission, propose that the Economic Commission for Latin America adopt the following resolution:

THE ECONOMIC COMMISSION FOR LATIN AMERICA

CONSIDERING: That the economic functions assigned to the Caribbean Commission under the Agreement of July 15, 1946 establishing that Commission, are broadly similar to those of the Economic Commission for Latin America; and that it would be desirable that there should be liaison and co-ordination between the activities of the two bodies;

INSTRUCTS the Executive Secretary to inform the Caribbean Commission of its desire for such liaison and co-ordination; and

INVITES the Caribbean Commission to consider and suggest to the Economic Commission for Latin America arrangements to that end.
