THE ECONOMIC COMMISSION FOR LATIN AMERICA

AGREES

1. To thank the Executive Secretary for their report he has presented on "Prospects for Trade Expansion";;
2. In accordance with the views put forward in the said report and those expressed by the various delegations in this Committee, to request the Executive Secretary to make arrangements for the carrying out, by experts to be designated by him, of the necessary investigations to obtain information on Latin America's true position in this field and formulate suggestions on the subject;
3. To request the Executive Secretary, on completion of these investigations, to give a full and documented report upon them to the States members of the ECLA, in order that these latter may decide, within a period of time, to be indicated by the Executive Secretary himself, whether a commission of experts of their Governments should be called to determine the plan of action to be taken.
