Costa Rica: Draft Resolution

THE ECONOMIC COMMISSION FOR LATIN AMERICA

CONSIDERING the resolution adopted at its third session (E/CN.12/204) dealing with collaboration with UNESCO, with special reference to measures to increase the availability of supplies of educational, scientific and cultural materials in Latin America,

TAKES NOTE of the progress report by the Executive Secretary on this matter (E/CN.12/230), in which it is stated that a questionnaire was sent to governments of the region in December 1950 in agreement with the Director General of UNESCO, designed to ascertain their import needs and export availabilities for a specific list of educational and scientific materials, and

RECOMMENDS to member governments that replies to the
