Proposed amendment to draft resolution E/CN.12/AC.14/9/Rev.1

Replace the last paragraph by the following text:

"REQUESTS the Executive Secretary to consult again with the Director-General of UNESCO with a view to establishing, at his discretion but as soon as possible, the Working Group envisaged in Resolution: (n) (E/CN.12/204) of the Commission at its Third Session, taking into consideration the possibility that the Working Group might first devote its attention to those aspects of the problem before it which could be adequately studied with the documentation or material already available to it, devoting special attention at the appropriate stage to the documentation which Governments submit in reply to the questionnaire referred to above".
