THE ECONOMIC COMMISSION FOR LATIN AMERICA,

NOTES with satisfaction the Executive Secretary's recommendation that an office of the Economic Commission for Latin America should be set up in Mexico City, as a branch office of ECLA Headquarters in Santiago, Chile, to cover the northern countries of Latin America;

NOTES that with the setting up of this office the Secretariat will be able to carry out its work more efficiently and economically;

ACCEPTS WITH PLEASURE the generous offer made by the government of Mexico to the United Nations, to place at the disposal of the ECLA office in Mexico all the necessary facilities; and
