ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT STUDIES BY COUNTRIES

Draft resolution approved by Committee II on 22 April 1953

THE ECONOMIC COMMISSION FOR LATIN AMERICA

CONSIDERING that comprehensive surveys of a country's economy constitute the fundamental basis for its development plans and that they may likewise be useful reference material for similar surveys in other countries;

TAKES NOTE with satisfaction of the study on the economic development of Ecuador (E/CN.12/295), submitted by the Secretariat; and

RECOMMENDS that the Secretariat should, if the countries so request and within the limits of its available resources, send working groups to carry out comprehensive surveys of the possibilities of economic development in accordance with the terms of General Assembly resolution 627 (VII).
