REPORT OF THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ON THE DEVELOPMENT
AND UTILIZATION OF HUMAN RESOURCES IN
DEVELOPING COUNTRIES

Note by the secretariat

The secretariat of the Economic Commission for Latin America wishes to draw the attention of the countries members of the Commission to the report of the Secretary-General of the United Nations on the development and utilization of human resources in developing countries (E/4353 and Add.1), of which a limited number of copies are available in the Documents Section. Its intention herein is to comply with resolution 1274 (XLIII) of the Economic and Social Council, in operative paragraph 6 of which the Council requests the regional economic commissions, in drawing up their work programmes and after having studied the report of the Secretary-General, to take account of the close relationship which should exist between the economic growth of the less developed countries and the social advancement of their population.

It should be pointed out that the work programme of the Economic Commission for Latin America for the period extending from May 1967 to May 1969 (E/4359/Add.1) had already been approved by the Commission in its resolution 280 (XII) of 11 May 1967 and adopted by the Economic and Social Council in its resolution 1247 (XLIII) of 21 July 1967.

The report of the Secretary-General which is the subject of the present note was distributed at United Nations Headquarters to all Governments of States Members of the United Nations on 8 May 1967.
