Chapter II. Programmed Analytical Tabulations.

After having indicated in Chapter I the different subjects to be included in the comparative study, it seems necessary to say some words about the set of tables programmed to perform the analysis.

This set of tabulations could undergo further adjustments both in quantity as well as in the number of categories considered for the variables, according to the results shown by the fertility indicators and the number of cases which support the determination of such measures.

These same reasons have been taken into consideration so that the tabulations which associate fertility indicators to differential variables be preceded by distribution tabulations to observe the relative importance of each subgroup of analysis.

At first glance one might get the wrong impression that the association which commonly exists between fertility and the differential variables considered will not be analyzed with the sufficient attention and extension.

Although it has been intended to keep a relatively handy number of analytical tabulations it can be verified that, despite careful attention the number of tabulations is relatively high. The only reason that could be indicated to justify this number of tabulations is that the analysis covers a wide variety of subjects and that for the analysis of each one of them an average of about - 30 specific tabulations can be foreseen.

Taking into account the quality of the information, in some cases women of different status have been placed into one common category which does not mean that some "pilot" tabulations have not been programmed where the subgroups integrating those categories are separated.

In some way, in other tabulations a greater number has been considered than the one which reasonably should exist - for example in the case of women's level of education - with the only purpose of locating more precisely the "cut points" where the fertility level changes under the hypothesis that those changing points are remarkably different in the surveyed countries.

On the other hand, in the tabulations project there is no indication of the "reliability" tabulations necessary to verify, indirectly, that the samples selected are representative of the populations of origin. Finally, tabulations with fertility indicators have not been considered neither have been some related variables that will permit to see that the changes achieved or to be achieved in the future are in adequate correspondence with the goals indicated in the development plans for that demographic component.

The trend analysis of some fertility indicators - for example, the general fertility rate - will make it imperative to consider the use of mathematic models which may allow us to infer with sufficient reliability the most probable value of the indicator when the experience of some cohorts of women in the child-bearing period is not available for the years previous to the survey.
