(a) **Objectives**

To promote the development of relevant statistics on natural resources and the environment and their integration into the national statistical systems of the countries of Latin America and the Caribbean.

To define strategies for implementation at the national level.

(c) **Expected outcomes from the seventh meeting of the Statistical Conference of the Americas of ECLAC (November 2013)**

- (i) Legal review of the agreement between Mexico's National Institute of Statistics and Geography (INEGI) and the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB) for execution of the regional public goods project Development and strengthening of official environmental statistics by creating a regional framework in Latin America and the Caribbean.
- (ii) Set up and operationalize the project's governing bodies, namely the Executive Committee and the Technical Committee, and commence project execution.
- (iii) Consolidate synergies between the Working Group on Environmental Indicators coordinated by UNEP and the Working Group on Environmental Statistics of SCA-ECLAC.

5. Progress to date

Officials at IDB are preparing the draft agreement for submission to and review by INEGI, with the specific elements of a standard document.

INEGI is conducting the legal review.

INEGI, which will act as the executing agency, has asked the members of the Working Group to designate representatives of the institutions that will comprise the Executive Committee and the Technical Committee for the project.
