1. Add a reference mark */ after the words "Chapter II" on page 105, and a footnote reading as follows:
*/ This chapter is a summary and updated account of some aspects of commercial and financial relations between Latin America and the European Economic Community that the ECLA secretariat has covered comprehensively and in detail in the following documents prepared for the meeting of the Special Committee on Latin American Co-ordination (CECLA) held at Buenos Aires between 20 and 31 July 1970:

2. Add a reference mark */ after the word "Montevideo", on the fourth line of page 108, and a footnote reading as follows:

*/ In this connexion it should be recalled that in 1964, on the initiative of the European Iron and Steel Community, an office was established in Santiago, Chile, for liaison with the Latin American Governments. This subsequently became the liaison office for the European Communities and since the end of 1970 is responsible for the information office in Montevideo.
