RESOLUTION OF 24 JUNE 1948 ON IMPORT AND EXPORT PRICES

THE ECONOMIC COMMISSION FOR LATIN AMERICA

CONSIDERING that many Latin-American countries have expressed concern as to the trend of the relationship between the prices of the commodities basic to their economies, including foodstuffs, and those of the manufactured products which they import;

REQUESTS the Executive Secretary in preparing the Economic Survey of Latin America, or in any special study, to make, in collaboration with • the International Monetary Fund and other specialized agencies, a study of the movements of import and export prices, the determining factors of such movements, and the consequences thereof on the balance of payments.
