ANNOTATED PROVISIONAL AGENDA

1. Adoption of the agenda

Once the agenda has been adopted, the organization of work for the two days of the meeting will be addressed.

2. Review of the activities of the Presiding Officers and the ECLAC secretariat since the twenty-third meeting of the Presiding Officers on 18 and 19 November 1996

Delegations will examine the activities carried out pursuant to the agreements reached at the twenty-third meeting and set out in document LC/L.999(MDM.23/3) of 26 March 1997. Special attention will be given to the steps taken to strengthen ties between the Presiding Officers and the member countries.

3. Preparations for the seventh session of the Regional Conference on the Integration of Women into the Economic and Social Development of Latin America and the Caribbean, to be held in Santiago, Chile, from 19 to 21 November 1997

Based on the agreements reached at the twenty-third meeting of the Presiding Officers, the twenty-fourth meeting will consider the following sub-items:

- 3.1 Provisional agenda for the seventh session of the Regional Conference on the Integration of Women into the Economic and Social Development of Latin America and the Caribbean
- 3.2 The Conference programme; schedule and organization of work during the session
- 3.3 Organization of information and dissemination activities
- 3.4 Working and reference documents
- 3.5 Participation by non-governmental organizations
- 3.6 Consideration of the content of the declaration or agreement to be adopted in Santiago
- 4. Composition of the next set of Presiding Officers

The meeting will consider the criteria for the composition of the next set of Presiding Officers, bearing in mind such factors the countries' regular attendance at meetings, representation of the subregions and other criteria the delegations may deem pertinent. To facilitate this task during the Conference session, the delegations may decide to hold prior informal consultations.

5. Other matters

The delegations may raise any other matters they consider it important to discuss.
