## REPORT ON THE ACTIVITIES OF THE WORKING GROUP ON INFORMATION AND COMMUNICATIONS TECHNOLOGIES $\ast$

## 1. Background

The activities of the Working Group on Information and Communications Technologies (ICTs) and the Observatory for the Information Society in Latin America and the Caribbean (OSILAC) are part of the biennial programme of regional and international cooperation activities, 2007-2009 of the Statistical Conference of the Americas of the Economic Commission for Latin America and the Caribbean (ECLAC) and the Partnership on Measuring ICT for Development; thus, the activities listed in this document may be coordinated by the Working Group, by OSILAC or by both entities working in conjunction or, should the case arise, by another member of the Partnership.

At the fourth meeting of the Statistical Conference of the Americas of ECLAC, the following programme of activities for the Working Group on Information and Communications Technologies was adopted at the recommendation of the latter:

- (a) To adopt and implement on an annual basis, according to the capacities of each national statistical office, the list of core indicators for ICT access and use in household and business surveys adopted in resolution 38/104 of the United Nations Statistical Commission, which will be updated in accordance with the progress made by the countries.<sup>1</sup>
- (b) To adopt as a methodological reference the compendium of best practices for the inclusion of ICT questions in household and business surveys.<sup>2</sup>
- (c) To request the Economic Commission for Latin America and the Caribbean to manage, through OSILAC and with the support of national statistical offices, the information system on ICT and social, demographic and economic indicators, and to keep the compendium updated.
- (d) To request the countries to send to ECLAC on a regular basis the data from their household and business surveys in relation to key indicators of ICT access and use, and also social, demographic and economic variables, together with their respective methodological manuals, in order to keep the information system and the compendium updated.

## 2. Programme of activities for 2008

The following programme of activities is proposed for the Working Group on Information and Communications Technology for 2008 to enable it to make headway with the implementation of the initiatives set out above.

Core indicators proposal regarding information and communication technologies (ICT). Working group on measuring Information and Communication Technologies (ICT) and (OSILAC) (DDR/5).
