Ninth meeting of the negotiating committee of the regional agreement on access to information, participation and justice in environmental matters in Latin America and the Caribbean

San José, 28 February-4 March 2018

DRAFT FINAL ACT

The representatives of the countries participating in the ninth meeting of the negotiating committee of the regional agreement on access to information, participation and justice in environmental matters in Latin America and the Caribbean, held in San José from 28 February to 4 March 2018,

- 1. *Adopt* the Regional Agreement on Access to Information, Public Participation and Justice in Environmental Matters in Latin America and the Caribbean (hereinafter referred to as "the Agreement"), the text of which is contained in annex 1;
- 2. Request the Presiding Officers of the negotiating committee to continue to steer and conduct the necessary work in the period between the date on which the Agreement will be opened for signature, as established in article xx, and the first meeting of the Conference of the Parties, with significant participation by the public and the support of the Economic Commission for Latin America and the Caribbean as technical secretariat;
- 3. *Agree* to report on the adoption of the Agreement at the thirty-seventh session of the Economic Commission for Latin America and the Caribbean, to be held in Havana from 7 to 11 May 2018, and request the Commission to agree to undertake the secretariat functions set out in article xx of the Agreement;
- 4. *Request* the Economic Commission for Latin America and the Caribbean to take the necessary steps to deposit the final text of the Agreement, as contained in annex 1, with the Secretary-General of the United Nations, in accordance with article xx of the Agreement;
- 5. *Invite* all Latin American and Caribbean States to sign the Agreement, in accordance with article xx thereof, and to deposit their respective instruments of ratification, acceptance, approval or accession, as appropriate, as soon as possible;

- 6. *Thank* the Economic Commission for Latin America and the Caribbean for its support as technical secretariat during the negotiation process, including the preparatory phase, and for its willingness to continue to serve as the secretariat of the Agreement;
- 7. *Also thank* the public and its representatives for their meaningful participation in the meetings of the negotiating committee and for their contributions;
- 8. *Express their gratitude* to the co-Chairs, the Presiding Officers of the negotiating committee and all the delegations for their dedication and commitment, and welcome the results obtained;
- 9. *Thank* the people and the Government of Costa Rica for their hospitality and the effort devoted to the organization of the ninth meeting of the negotiating committee.
