THE COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE OF THE ECONOMIC COMMISSION FOR LATIN AMERICA,
CONSIDERING that from the first meetings of the Commission the Member
Governments have insisted on the importance of transportation and power in
economic development;

CONSIDERING that no special studies have been made on these subjects
and that their preparation would be an effective contribution to the
formulation of economic development plans and programmes;

REQUESTS the Executive Secretary, in relation to the economic
development of Latin America, to carry out studies on an ad hoc basis:

- (a) on transport problems including working conditions and
mechanization of Latin American ports and their comparative
operating costs;
- (b) on power supplies and requirements.
