## INTRODUCTION

This document reports on the progress made in the implementation of the work programmes of the 16 working groups of the Statistical Conference of the Americas of the Economic Commission for Latin America and the Caribbean (ECLAC) for the 2018-2019 biennium, as adopted by the Conference. ${ }^{1}$ The progress is presented in the form of tables which, for ease of reading, are structured around activities or final outputs that the working groups expect to have ready for regional dissemination towards the end of the current biennium. The tables contain a description of the various activities and outputs planned for the period, along with their status (in progress, finalized or not started) and a percentage of progress thus far as reported by the coordinating body of each working group. The outputs are categorized in order to facilitate their systematization and dissemination in due course.

On the basis of the information received, of the total activities planned for this biennium, $41.8 \%$ have not started yet, while the percentage of implementation of those that have begun was $65 \%$ (simple average) at September 2018. By type of output, 101 are documents (meeting reports, analytical studies and dissemination of findings, working materials and methodologies), 60 are events (meetings, seminars and courses), 18 are media resources (videos, websites, bulletins, and so forth) and 16 are methodological tools (databases, indicator suites, questionnaires).

## 6. WORKING GROUP ON ENVIRONMENTAL STATISTICS

## 1. Objectives ${ }^{1}$

## (a) General objective

Strengthen capacities for the development of environmental statistics, indicators and accounts relevant to the countries of the region, with emphasis on the production of environmental indicators for the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), climate change indicators and urban environmental indicators.

## (b) Specific objectives

(i) Strengthen statistical work in environmental matters in the community of peers, by promoting collaboration among the countries and facilitating dialogue; share experiences and outcomes; and manage knowledge about solutions and adaptations needed to produce sustainable environment statistics.
(ii) Contribute to statistical development and the harmonized production of environmental SDG indicators that are regionally relevant.
(iii) Facilitate and nurture the development of a regionally-relevant programme of work on climate change statistics and indicators, with emphasis on the impact of disasters and adaptation.
(iv) Promote and facilitate the building and strengthening of statistical and institutional capacities in the area of environmental statistics in the countries of the region.
(v) Promote and monitor the development of relevant environmental accounts in the region.
(vi) Promote urban environmental indicators that are relevant to the region, in particular those related to Sustainable Development Goal 11 (Make cities and human settlements inclusive, safe, resilient and sustainable).
(vii) Contribute to efforts to strengthen and foster links between the geospatial community and environmental statistics in the countries of the region.

## 2. Rationale

Environmental statistics and indicators is the newest and least developed statistical area within the data that countries have to produce in order to report on their national sustainable development plans and their progress in the implementation of the SDGs and their international commitments. In this regard, the regional collaborative work within the Statistical Conference of the Americas of the Economic Commission for Latin America and the Caribbean (ECLAC) must be continued and strengthened in an effort to accelerate development in this statistical domain, focusing on three areas of high and growing demand for quantitative environmental information for the 2018-2019 biennium: environmental SDG indicators; evidence of the impact of climate change on the countries of the region and their adaptation efforts; and urban environmental indicators.

## 3. Members of the Working Group

While the Working Group member countries will be consulted on the Group's activities, all specialists in the region will be convened to meetings and updated on a regular basis, an information web page on universal access will be built, and the Working Group will report regularly to the Statistical Conference of the Americas of ECLAC and the relevant agencies.

## 4. Work plan

The objectives set for the biennium will be addressed and achieved by linking the major areas of work (training, horizontal cooperation and dissemination) to various activities such as virtual and in-person training, conducting webinars, connecting specialized South-South technical cooperation, technical assistance missions, consultations and meetings with regional experts on environmental statistics, undertaking advocacy activities to strengthen environmental statistics in the countries of the region, and developing a web page to disseminate all the Working Group's information, among other things. ECLAC, serving as the technical secretariat, already has funding to carry out several of these activities throughout the biennium.
