**CHANGE OF NAME OF THE LATIN AMERICAN INSTITUTE FOR ECONOMIC
AND SOCIAL PLANNING**



Note by the Secretariat

1. At the seventh session of the Technical Subcommittee of ILPES, held in Brasilia in December 1984, it was decided to submit to the sixth session of the Technical Committee (Mexico City, 16 April 1985) the proposal to change the name of the Institute to "Latin American and Caribbean Institute for Economic and Social Planning".
2. The Technical Committee's decision was based on the fact that ECLAC, of whose system ILPES is a part, has already changed its name and it is appropriate that the Institute should make a similar change, not only in order to keep in line with the Commission, but also in order that the name of the Institute should reflect the strong impulse which ILPES is giving to its activities in the Caribbean.
3. In view of the foregoing, the sixth session of the Technical Committee of ILPES agreed to the change of name of ILPES as described above, while at the same time it was decided to maintain the acronym "ILPES" in view of the fact that it is in general use in all languages and the Institution is known under that acronym in the entire region.
4. In order to make this change of name effective, governments must adopt a resolution to this effect at the session of the Committee of the Whole, for subsequent submission to the United Nations Economic and Social Council.
